

Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station



Located in Oak Harbor, Ohio, the 954-acre site is situated on Lake Erie, east of Toledo.

Facts At A Glance

- Davis-Besse, a single unit pressurized water reactor, produces 908 megawatts of electricity, enough to power more than 750,000 homes.
- The plant received its license in 1977 and is currently licensed to operate through 2037.
- The plant employs more than 720 people.
- Paid more than \$4 million annually in personal and real property taxes for tax year 2017.

Environmental Measures

In conjunction with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, the plant operates and maintains the adjacent 733 acres of “Navarre Marsh” wetlands as part of Ottawa National Wildlife Refuge.

The plant emits no pollutants into the air and reduces our dependence on fossil fuels.
